

# SHORT-TERM MANAGEMENT SPECIFICATIONS PROPOSAL Floodplain Woodland – Lake Roland Nature Center

#### **PROJECT AREA**

Approximately five acres of existing floodplain woodland behind the Lake Roland Nature Center in Lake Roland Park. The area includes the woodland shown on the Concept Design prepared by LWLA and Carol Franklin (plan dated 1/25/17).

Any other areas of the Park are outside the scope of this proposal.

#### **PROJECT OBJECTIVES**

Prepare Short-Term Habitat Management Specifications with strategies for immediate implementation or implementation in the near future. Recommendations will take into account tasks that can be reasonably conducted by volunteers and tasks that are best performed by trained professionals. The short-term management strategies will be designed to:

- Stabilize the vegetative health of the project area through actions that target problem weeds in favor of desirable existing growth.
- Be practical to perform over large areas.
- Where possible, enhance wildlife habitat in the short term through simple procedures.

#### SCOPE OF SERVICES

Spring Site Analysis Visit the site in the spring to assess existing vegetation, both desirable

and undesirable.

Take photographs and necessary field measurements.

Make preliminary notes regarding management recommendations.

Note: The site analysis visit will be timed to occur once the majority of herbaceous

vegetation has emerged and is clearly identifiable.

Draft Guidelines Prepare a draft of the Short-Term Management Specifications.

Review with Client Weet with the Client via phone and screen share to review the draft

Short-Term Management Specifications.

Finalize Guidelines Incorporate revisions from the Client meeting to finalize the Short-Term

Management Specifications.

#### **DELIVERABLES**

**Short-Term Management Specifications** – Management procedures will be detailed in written form with supporting graphics as necessary. Includes the following sections:

- A. Management Objectives List of short-term management objectives.
- B. *Vegetation Observed* A list of desirable and undesirable vegetation observed within the project area at the time of the site visit or on prior visits.
- C. Short-Term Management Calendar Easy-to-follow "at-a-glance" calendar of recommended short-term management procedures.
- D. Detailed Task Descriptions & Rationales Detailed descriptions of all recommended short-term management tasks, their timing, and rationales for these tasks. Includes supporting graphics where relevant.

Note: The Short-Term Management Guidelines will be in support of the habitat goals identified in the Concept Plan already provided by LWLA and Carol Franklin. Fully detailed management specifications for any future plantings can be provided at the appropriate point in the design documentation process.

## FEE

**Terms** The above fee is applicable for one (1) year from the date of this proposal.

The above fee does not include reimbursable travel expenses for 2 LWLA staff (estimated at \$750). These expenses will be billed to the Client at cost.

All services listed above include designer oversight.

This proposal includes one site visit and one web-based meeting. Additional meetings will be considered Additional Services. Each meeting will have an added cost of \$125 per hour for firm principal and \$85 per hour for an associate (plus all related expenses).

Arborist tree assessment is outside the scope of this proposal. This service can be contracted through the writing of an additional proposal if desired.

### **Payment Schedule**

50% retainer upon acceptance of this proposal. 25% due upon completion of Design Round 1. Balance due upon completion of all proposed work.
